My latest design is one that many of you have asked for. The Beechcraft A36 Straight Tailed Bonanza is a general aviation aircraft first introduced in 1947 by The Beech Aircraft Corporation of Wichita, Kansas. It has been in continuous production longer than any other airplane in history. More than 17,000 Bonanzas of all variants have been built. With comfortable cabins, cruise speeds near 200 mph and a range of around 1,000 miles, Bonanzas are considered by many pilots to be the Primer private flying machine. Today's well equipped Bonanzas are priced at around \$200,000.00 and up. My A36 is made from Budweiser Beer Cans but it can be made from any 12 or 16 oz beverage Can. These instructions can easily be modified to also make Pipers and Ballancas as well as other low-wing aircraft.

The B. C. Air Originals Beechcraft A36 Straight Tailed Bonanza is another great FUN project you'll really enjoy. It's a straight forward, quick build, and great looking airplane. (This model may even be large enough to hold servos. Does that give you any ideas?)
